Main Presentation – Intro to Design Methods of Solar Systems

It goes through the types of Solar systems, Discussion of codes relating to these system, the components and design fundamentals and considerations. WE go deep into the fire codes and building codes related to the solar systems and ways to make it both efficient and safe.
