The 2014 New York City Energy Conservation Code

This presentation gives a synopsis of the requirements of the 2014 New York City Energy Conservation Code. This code is based upon IECC 2012 but includes a number of important amendments, including some amendments to ASHRAE Standard 90.1-2010 that is referenced in IECC. The presentation includes an introduction to the submission requirements and to the inspection protocols required to insure that the constructed works are consistent with the submitted documentation.
